2. Personal Data We Process

Feelerz processes your personal data because you use our services or provide this data to us directly. The personal data we may process includes:

- First and last name
- Phone number
- Email address (business)
- Other personal data you actively provide (e.g., in correspondence or phone conversations)
- IP address
- Internet browser and device type

3. Special and/or Sensitive Personal Data

Feelerz does not intend to collect data from visitors under 16 years of age unless they have parental or guardian consent. However, we cannot verify the age of visitors. 4. Purpose and Legal Basis for Processing Personal Data

Feelerz processes your personal data for the following purposes:

- Sending newsletters (with your consent)
- Allowing you to publish your company data, including your business email to your other 3rd parties / organizations selected by you.

5. Automated Decision-Making

Feelerz does not make decisions based solely on automated processing that could have significant consequences for individuals. All decisions involve human oversight.

6. Data Retention

Feelerz retains your personal data no longer than necessary to achieve the purposes for which it was collected. Specifically:

- Contract-related information is retained for five years.
- Other information is retained for six months after the contract expires.

7. Sharing Personal Data with Third Parties

Feelerz does not sell your personal data to third parties. We only share data when necessary to fulfill our contract with you or comply with legal obligations. If third parties process your data on our behalf, we enter into a data processing agreement to ensure the same level of security and confidentiality. Feelerz remains responsible for these data processing activities.

8. Cookies and Similar Technologies

Feelerz uses technical, functional, and analytical cookies to ensure the proper functioning of the website and application to improve user experience. You can adjust your browser settings to decline cookies or delete stored cookies.

9. Accessing, Modifying, or Deleting Your Data

You have the right to access, correct, or delete your personal data. You may also withdraw your consent for data processing or object to how we process your data. Additionally, you have the right to data portability, allowing you to request that we transfer your data to another organization of your choice.
